#### **PROGRAMME AIM:**

#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

- ▶ A Pass in Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM/SPMV) with at least credit in three (3) subjects; OR
- ▶ A Pass in Unified Examination Certificate (UEC) with at least Grade B in 3 subjects; OR
- A Pass in O-Level with at least Grade C in 3 subjects; OR
- A Pass in Sijil Kemahiran Malaysia (SKM) Level 3 Early Childhood Education / Preschool; and a pass in SPM with at least credit in one (1) subject; OR
- A Pass in Sijil Kolej Komuniti (Level 3, MQF) in related field; and a pass in SPM with at least credit in one (1) subject; and
- ▶ A Pass in Certificate in Early Childhood Education (Level 3, MQF) in related field with minimum CGPA 2.00; OR
- A Pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) or its equivalent with at least Grade C (GP of 2.0) in one (1) subject; OR
- A Pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with a Grade of Maabul; OR
- > Any other equivalent qualifications recognized by the Malaysian Government. > For international students it is compulsory to obtain a minimum score of 5.0 for IELTS or its equivalent.
- \* Entry requirement for each programme is subject to MOHE's approval
